Gaslamp Quarter Trolley Trip and Tour

Take the trolley Downtown to the San Diego Gaslamp Quarter for an afternoon of exploration and historical facts. Begin the day exploring the downtown area and having lunch at the restaurant of your choice, followed by a guided walking tour of the Gaslamp Quarter. The 90 minute tour starts at the William Heath Davis House and Museum built in 1850 and continues onto other architecturally significant structures of the period along with fascinating stories of the people and characters that shaped the destiny of San Diego. Trip will occur rain or shine and walking distance will be approximately 1.7 miles.

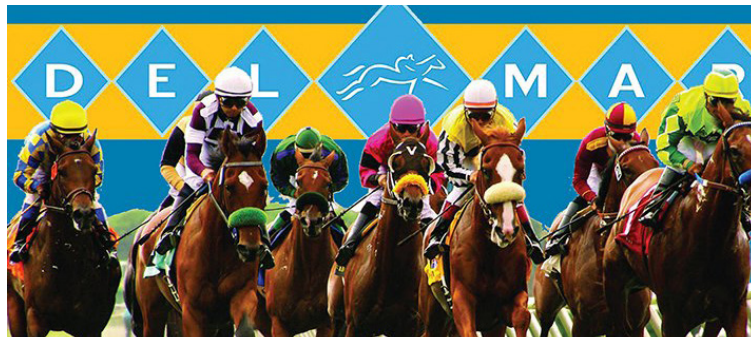
