How much does it cost to participate in Santee Salutes?

Santee Salutes is a free event. However, there is a nominal fee for food and drinks, activities in the Fun Zone, glow necklaces, face painting and t-shirts. There will be ATMs on-site next to the info booth and fun zone.

Where will the band be playing? And can I bring chairs or a blanket?

The band will be playing on the main stage adjacent to the parking lot. **BAND WILL PLAY AFTER THE FIREWORKS SHOW UNTIL 10:00PM.** The venue is set up for lawn and picnic style seating. Remember to bring your chairs and blankets. Canopies and umbrellas are allowed behind the designated canopy line. We ask that the canopies be sandbagged down because stakes are not allowed. Seating is first come, first served. All canopies and umbrellas need to be taken down at dusk to prevent view obstruction of the fireworks show.

Are there other activities to take part in at Santee Salutes?

There will be a Fun Zone located West of the synthetic turf fields that will have carnival games and rides. There is a minimal cost for activities in the Fun Zone. There is a playground on site located on the North/West side of the park and plenty of room to bring soccer balls, footballs etc. to play in the park.

Will there be food and drink available on site? If yes, what kind?

Yes, there will be food trucks and food vendors. Participants are allowed to bring their own food and drinks (glass containers and BBQ's are prohibited; beer and wine are allowed due to a park permit in place for this event).

Is this a rain or shine event?

Yes, the event will be held rain or shine.

What should I wear?

It tends to be warm when the event begins but does cool off later in the evening. A light jacket is recommended.

Do I need mosquito spray?

Yes, we recommend it. The park is located between the San Diego River and Woodglen Vista Creek. Vector Control has been continuously spraying in the surrounding area and we sprayed the event site this morning as well. We have bug spray for participants to use at the info booth.

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, dogs are welcome at the event as long as they are well behaved, on a leash no longer than 6 ft, and you have doggie bags on hand.

Where are the restrooms located?

Restrooms are located at the North/West side of the park in the permanent building along with Porta-potties banks located around the event.

Parking Lots:

SPECIAL NOTE: THE VIP/ADA PARKING LOT IS CLOSED TO ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FROM 8:30-9:30PM FOR THE FIREWORKS SHOW.

Tailgating is prohibited

The parking lot at Town Center Community Park East will be closed down during the fireworks show; no cars will be able to come in or out during this time due to an increase number of pedestrians in the parking lot.

Additional Parking:

Additional parking is available at Costco, Rio Seco School and the School District parking lot. A continuous **free** shuttle service will be available from 3:30 to 10:00pm from the Costco parking lot, Town Center Community Park West and the event site.

RV Parking:

RV parking is only allowed at Costco and will be free.

Unloading and Loading Zone:

Unloading and loading zone is located at the YMCA parking lot by the foot bridge.

YMCA & City of Santee Aquatics Center: The facility will be open 7:00am-2:00pm. Lap pool will be open from 7:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m. and Activity pool will be 9-11 a.m., 11:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m.). The pool will be free.

Streets with limited resident traffic or no parking only during evening hours:

Bilteer Drive, Bilteer Court, San Remo Court, San Remo Drive, Conejo Place, Magnolia Park Drive, Verde Vista Lane, Day Creek Trail and Leavesly Trail. No parking on Riverwalk Dr. and at Edgemoor Hospital. Area residents are encouraged to safely secure dogs or bring them inside.
