This Regular Meeting of the Santee City Council, the CDC Successor Agency, and the Santee Public Financing Authority was called to order by Vice Mayor/Vice Chair John W. Minto at 7:04 p.m.

Principal Traffic Engineer Minjie Mei presented the staff report utilizing a PowerPoint presentation and answered Council's questions.

ACTION: On motion of Council Member McNelis, seconded Council Member Dale, the Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a professional services agreement with Chen Ryan Associates Incorporated in an amount not to exceed \$116,440 and accelerate the appropriation of \$16,440 in Traffic Mitigation Fees from FY 2014-15 to FY 2013-14 was adopted with all voting aye, except Mayor Voepel who was absent.

(B) Resolution awarding the construction contract for the Citywide Pavement Repair and Rehabilitation Program (CIP 2013-03) and appropriating funds. (Reso 80-2013)

Principal Civil Engineer Carl Schmitz presented the staff report utilizing a PowerPoint presentation and answered Council's questions.

ACTION: On motion of Council Member McNelis, seconded Council Member Dale, the Resolution awarding the construction contract to SRM Contracting and Paving for a total amount of \$434,095, authorizing the Director of Development services to approve change orders in an amount not to exceed \$43,409 and appropriating Traffic Mitigation Fees in the amount of \$502,504 was adopted with all voting aye, except Mayor Voepel who was absent.
