For your safety and enjoyment please observe the following rules, maintain course integrity.

All Mast Park rules are applicable to the Disc Golf course, please review park rules sign and note the following:

- No smoking in city parks.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times. Please pick up after your pet.
- Any person bringing a pet into a city park or recreation area is solely responsible for the action of such pet.
- Alcohol is not permitted in the park Monday-Friday without a City-issued permit. Liquor, glass containers and keg beer are not allowed.

Fees/Procedures:

- Disc golf user fees will be used to assist in off-setting course maintenance expenses.
- Automated payment machine located on west side of the concession stand. (no cash, credit cards only)
- Youth under 18 years – Free/no charge.
- Adult Day Pass (18 years and over) – Weekdays: \$4/Weekends \$5.
- Monthly Adult Pass \$20 Santee residents/\$25 Non-residents (purchase through www.santeerec.com (service fee applies) or through the Community Services Department are available for purchase on the 20th of each month for the following month.
- Annual pass (details pending)
- Unlimited rounds of play for Day/Monthly Pass. (dawn – dusk)
- Receipts are issued at the payment machine: All adult disc golf players must have a dated pass in their possession during play.
- Receipts must be presented to Park Monitor upon request.

Course Courtesy:

- Respect park neighbors; keep volume down, especially during early morning hours and by holes 5 & 6.
- This a family friendly park, refrain from using foul language.
- Never throw when players or park users are within range. Always give park users the right of way. Be aware of your surroundings and environment.
- Do not go onto private property to retrieve lost discs.
- Stand behind the player who is throwing until throw is complete.
- Remain quiet and avoid unnecessary movements while others are throwing.
- Remove disc from basket after completing the hole.
- Help new players learn the rules.
- Allow faster groups to play through when possible.
- Do not alter the course (trees, bushes, etc.) in any way.
