Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed TCSP would involve expanding the overall TCSP boundary by approximately 41 acres (from 610 acres to 651 acres), creating five distinct, yet interconnected neighborhoods, and updating the land use and development standards within the TCSP consistent with densities and intensities established by existing zoning and the adopted and certified 2021-2029 Housing Element. The project would also expand the Arts and Entertainment Overlay District by 170 acres (from 172 acres to 342 acres) and rename the area the Arts and Entertainment Neighborhood. Finally, the proposed TCSP includes conceptual plans and development options to facilitate housing on each of the four Housing Element sites consistent with the density maximums of the adopted Housing Element and state density bonus law. Based on the analysis and conclusions of the DPEIR, the City of Santee finds that the proposed Project would result in significant Project-specific impacts associated with aesthetics, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, land use, noise, transportation, and tribal cultural resources. Where feasible, Project-specific impacts would be reduced to less than significant with the implementation of identified mitigation measures. However, Project-specific impacts associated with the following topics of study may remain significant and unavoidable: air quality, hazards and land use compatibility related to airport density limitations, noise, and transportation.
