3. UPDATES ON NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH AND CRIME PREVENTION EVENTS:

Julia Diaz stated there will be a "National Night Out" on August 3rd, 2021 at Santee Trolley Center. This event will have several law enforcement divisions present (i.e.; ASTREA, Search and Rescue teams etc.)

Sheriff's Department is encouraging Neighborhood Watch Teams – need neighborhood contact to take the lead

Mayor, John Minto addressed the television viewers and shared that there was no one in attendance and he encouraged that the community attend the COMPOC meetings.

4. DISCUSSION – UPCOMING TOPIC AND PRESENTATIONS IDEAS

Mayor Minto addressed each panelist for their ideas of future topics and presentations. Topics included: Food Bank; Elder Abuse; Human Trafficking; local crime updates; seniors; traffic; homeless resources; childhood – early prevention efforts;

Presentation suggestions were: CPTED (Crime Prevention through Environmental Design), PERT (Psychiatric Emergency response Team), PACES (Positive and Adverse Childhood Experiences); Homelessness Outreach Team; Food Bank, school district Safety Plans; Fire Dept. Search and Rescue team and K-9; commercial security; Bullying by the YMCA or Boys and Girls Club; Crime Stoppers, Alcohol Regulation;

Marlene stated that the *City of Santee is looking for 2 contractors. One contractor to focus efforts in producing a survey to our community and the other contractor to analyze survey results and trends to specifically identify the values of our community and how we can achieve the appropriate goals.

Then use results and strategies to begin Town Hall process.

Linda Roach stated that it will be vital that the results be thorough and in a timely manner. Community will need to know that their concerns will be heard.

Marlene stated that the Santee Summer Concerts are starting June 24th at Town Center Community Park at 6:30pm.

Julia stated that there was a Theft Meeting for Retailers two weeks ago and only 7 retailers attended. Another meeting will happen in December.

Mike Aiken questioned if there was any viewership tracking of the *new* Santee TV. Marlene stated that they are working on that at this time but the City Council meetings have been popular.
