UPDATES ON NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH AND CRIME PREVENTION: Jacob Donnan shared that the Sheriff's department participated in the XFEST at Pathways Church; Conducted a DUI checkpoint where 2 arrests were made; also this Saturday the Sheriff's Department will be at the Santee historical society's safety fair.
- 4. PRESENTATION: County of San Diego Behavioral Health Services: Director Luke Bergman gave a presentation on the initiatives that the Department of Behavioral Health Services are implementing for the mental health crisis response emergency system. Mr. Bergman included details regarding CSU's (Crisis Stabilized Units) and the importance they provide to those who are handling or involved in a mental health crisis. He included details of

RBC's (Recovery Bridge Centers) which will provide a safe and supervised environment to those who are intoxicated. Discussion was held.

- 5. DIVERSITY, EQUITY and INCLUSION (DEI) Community Values Update: Recreation Manager, Anne Morrison stated that an event related to Community Values is being planned in Spring 2024 and staff is collaborating on the logistics and elements. Discussion was held.
- **6. COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC/STAFF:** Dr. Mark Foreman stated that while we memorialize September 11, we should also remember how our lives changed on September 12 and what we brought forward.

Bonnie Baranoff shared that the San Diego River Park Foundation is having their homelessness census count this Saturday (9/16). She added that CASA initiatives for housing advocacy are working on updating the pocket guides for resources, as well as the website ECAssist.org.
