### **SUMMARY**

This Item asks the City Council to waive the reading in full of all Ordinances on the Agenda (if any) and approve their reading by title only. The purpose of this Item is to help streamline the City Council meeting process, to avoid unnecessary delay and to allow more time for substantive discussion of Items on the Agenda.

State law requires that all Ordinances be read in full either at the time of introduction or at the time of passage, unless a motion waiving further reading is adopted by a majority of the City Council. (Gov. Code, § 36934). This means that each word in each Ordinance would have to be read aloud unless such reading is waived. Such reading could substantially delay the meeting and limit the time available for discussion of substantive Items. Adoption of this waiver streamlines the procedure for adopting the Ordinances on tonight's Agenda (if any), because it allows the City Council to approve Ordinances by reading aloud only the title of the Ordinance instead of reading aloud every word of the Ordinance.

The procedures for adopting Resolutions are not as strict as the procedures for adopting Ordinances. For example, Resolutions do not require two readings for passage, need not be read in full or even by title, are effective immediately unless otherwise specified, do not need to be in any particular format unless expressly required, and, with the exception of fixing tax rates or revenue amounts, do not require publication. However, like Ordinances, all Resolutions require a recorded majority vote of the total membership of the City Council. (Gov. Code § 36936).

Series EKG monitor/defibrillator with associated necessary accessories; two (2) six-hour rechargeable smart batteries; one (1) AutoPulse automated, mechanical CPR board; three (3) AutoPulse lithium-ion batteries and related equipment and supplies. All items are to be purchased from Zoll Medical Corporation for the Fire Department to replace older technology equipment currently in service on ambulances and first-responder apparatus.

Santee Municipal Code Section 3.24.130 authorizes the City to purchase equipment and supplies from a vendor at a price established by competitive or competitively negotiated bid by another public agency as long as that bid substantially complied with the formal bidding procedures in Santee Municipal Code Section 3.24.100. City staff recommends that the EKG monitor/defibrillator, EKG batteries and related supplies be purchased pursuant to National Purchasing Partners ("NPP") Contract #VH11129 with Zoll Medical Corporation ("Zoll"). The City has determined that the publicly-bid NPP Contract #VH11129 substantially complied with the City's formal bidding procedures set forth in Santee Municipal Code Section 3.24.100. In addition, staff recommends the purchase of one AutoPulse CPR board, AutoPulse batteries and related supplies from Zoll as a sole source purchase in accordance with Santee Municipal Code Sections 3.24.120 and 3.24.020 as these items must match or be compatible with other Zoll equipment presently used by the Fire Department and these items will be purchased directly from the authorized manufacturer.

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**FINANCIAL STATEMENT** Adequate funding for the purchase of one (1) X Series EKG monitor/defibrillator, two (2) six-hour rechargeable smart batteries, one (1) AutoPulse CPR board, three (3) AutoPulse lithium-ion batteries and related equipment and supplies is included in the FY 2020-21 Emergency Medical Services (CSA-69) adopted budget.

### Background

### Zoll Monitors

In 2015, we started the replacement of all EKG monitors due to old technology and exhaustion of service life. This replacement plan consists of the continual replacement of two (2) monitors per fiscal year for four (4) years. Upon completion of the monitor replacement plan, we will continue the purchase of one (1) EKG monitor per year until all frontline and reserve apparatus have an EKG monitor as part of their respective standing inventory. This will allow for greater flexibility and availability of resources should equipment fail, need servicing, or additional units need to be placed in service. The total number of monitors we will have in our inventory will be 12 upon completion of this six-year plan. Upon the conclusion of this six-year replacement and purchase plan, we will continue with the purchase of one EKG monitor per fiscal year to replace monitors that will be approaching the expiration of their service life. This mirrors the practice currently in place in Lakeside Fire Protection District, with whom we share the responsibility of servicing CSA 69. Additionally, the purchase of the monitors has been budgeted for in the FY 2020/21 budget and will be reimbursed through the County of San Diego CSA 69 contract.

#### Zoll AutoPulse

We have purchased two (2) AutoPulse CPR devices over the past two years to replace older models that have surpassed their service life by over three years, each being ten years old. We currently have one remaining AutoPulse that will be replaced this budget year and placed on our frontline Medic 4. The AutoPulse from M4 will be moved to a Type 1 Fire Engine. This purchase is part of a four-year plan to replace older models and increase our total available CPR boards to five (5). This is part of a larger goal of creating two "turn-key" paramedic reserve ambulances and place AutoPulses on all frontline fire apparatus. Additionally, the purchase of the AutoPulse has been budgeted for in the FY 2020/21 budget and will be reimbursed through the County of San Diego CSA 69 contract.

### **SUMMARY**

On August 14, 2019, City Council determined that the vacant parcel of real property located in Trolley Square identified as Parcel 4 of Map 18857 ("Property") was not appropriate for a public library. On September 5, 2019, the City and Excel Acquisitions, LLC entered into an Exclusive Negotiation Agreement ("ENA") to negotiate the terms of a Disposition and Development Agreement ("DDA") for the possible future construction of a hotel on Parcel 4, subject to all applicable legal requirements, including, without limitation the California Environmental Quality Act. On December 11, 2019, in accordance with Government Code section 37420 et seq., the City Council adopted a resolution finding that the public interest and convenience require the sale of the Property and declaring its intent to sell the Property. Since entering into the ENA, City staff and Excel have been negotiating the terms of a proposed DDA.

A Public Hearing to consider the DDA with Excel was first scheduled for January 8, 2020, but has been continued by the City Council, most recently to August 26, 2020. The City and Excel need additional time to negotiate the terms of the DDA. For this reason, it is recommended that the Public Hearing be continued to November 18, 2020.

### **CEQA COMPLIANCE**

The continuance of this public hearing to allow for continued negotiations and discussions between the City and Excel regarding the DDA is not a project subject to CEQA review under State CEQA Guidelines section 15378. The proposed hotel project subject to the DDA was previously analyzed under CEQA in the Supplemental Environmental Checklist for the Arts and Entertainment Overlay District adopted by the City on December 11, 2019. No approval action has been taken for the proposed hotel project, however, as negotiations between the parties are still ongoing and the City has made no legal commitment to the hotel.

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If the City approves the DDA, the City would gain the purchase price of \$1.4 million, minus sale costs.
