DECLARATION OF ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

SUMMARY

A General Municipal Election for one Mayor, one Member of the City Council, District 3, and one Member of the City Council, District 4, and for the submission to the voters of three ballot measures, was held and conducted in the City of Santee, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Pursuant to Resolution No. 059-2020 adopted June 24, 2020, the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Clerk of the City of Santee. This item is placed before the City Council in order to declare the results of the November 3, 2020 General Municipal Election. The certified election results are attached to the Resolutions.

On December 7, 2020, a request for a recount of votes cast for candidates for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4, in the November 3, 2020 election, was submitted to the Registrar of Voters. Staff recommends that the election results for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4, be declared after the recount is complete, at a Regular or Special Meeting of the City Council. Council has the legal authority to declare all of the election results as certified by the ROV (Option B) or to wait to declare the District 4 results until the recount is completed (Option A).

The City Clerk shall enter into the minutes a statement of the results and administer the Oath of Office to the elected officials. Certificates of Election were provided on December 8, 2020.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

A total of \$202,000 is budgeted for costs related to the November 3, 2020 General Municipal Election. Advance deposits were recently paid to the Registrar of Voters Office in the amounts of \$30,000 for the Mayoral election, \$25,000 total for the two City Council district elections and \$141,000 total for the three ballot measures. In addition, the budget includes \$6,000 for other election-related costs incurred by the City. The final cost should be provided to the City by the Registrar of Voters Office in the next several months. The party who requested the recount is required to pay a deposit to the ROV to cover the cost of the recount. If the recount changes the result of the election, the deposit will be refunded by the ROV.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTEE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020, DECLARING THE RESULTS AND SUCH OTHER MATTER AS PROVIDED BY LAW

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Santee, California, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that candidates were nominated to fill the vacancies as provided by law; that voting precincts and Districts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California relating to charter cities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 59-2020 adopted, June 24, 2020, the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City Clerk of the City of Santee and said results are received, attached and made a part hereof as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2020, a request for a recount of votes cast for candidates for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4, in the November 3, 2020 election, was submitted to the Registrar of Voters; and

WHEREAS, the election results for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4, will be declared following the completion of the recount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santee, California. as follows:

SECTION 1. That the number of ballot cards cast (each ballot is comprised of 1 card) in the City was as follows:

Mayor -32,600 District 3 - 8,085

Measure N – 32,600 Measure Q – 32,600 Measure R – 32,600

SECTION 2. That the names of persons voted for and the number of votes cast at said election for Office of Mayor of said City are as follows:

SECTION 3. That the names of persons voted for and the number of votes cast at said election for Office of Member of the City Council, District 3 of said City are as follows:

Laura Koval number of votes received: <u>5,842</u>

SECTION 4. That on December 7, 2020, a request for a recount of votes cast for candidates for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4, in the November 3, 2020 election, was submitted to the Registrar of Voters and that the names of persons voted for and the number of votes cast at said election for Office of Member of the City Council, District 4 of said City will be declared after the recount is completed, at a Regular or Special Meeting of the City Council.

SECTION 5. That the measures voted upon and the number of votes cast at said election for each measure are as follows:

SECTION 6. That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons and each of the measures above named are as listed in Exhibit A.

SECTION 7. The City Council does declare and determine that:

John W. Minto was elected as Mayor of said City for the full term of four years; and

Laura Koval was elected as Member of the City Council, District 3 of said City for the full term of four years; and

A majority of voters voting on Measure N did vote in favor of it, and that the measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified; and

A majority of voters voting on Measure Q did vote in favor of it, and a majority of voters voting on Measure R did vote in favor of it. Measure R received the highest number of affirmative votes and therefore pursuant to Elections Code section 9221, Measure R was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City a statement of the results of the election, attached hereto as Exhibit A, showing:

SECTION 9. That the City Clerk shall deliver a Certificate of Election signed and duly authenticated to the Mayor and Member of the City Council, District 3, upon compliance with the provisions of the Elections Code and the Government Code of the State of California, and that the City Clerk shall also administer to the Mayor and Member of the City Council, District 3, the Oath of Office as prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe thereto and file the same in the City Clerk's Office. Whereupon, each and all of said persons so elected shall be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

SECTION 10. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
