Nick informed the committee that Walker Trail lodge pole fencing has been completed; Park kiosks are on order, and will be installed at a variety of parks, including Big Rock Pickleball area; the Community Clean-Up and Shred Day was successful; Community Center planning is ongoing and updates will be provided soon.

Anne Morrison showed the recap video of Fido Fest where it was well attended and successful. Anne also presented a video of Hop Down the Bunny Trail, which was another successful well-attended event. Anne spoke about the upcoming Summer Concerts and the Friday Nights Live events happening at Trolley Square starting May 19. Anne presented a video on the Spring Recreational Classes – registration currently open. Anne stated that recruitment is happening for part-time recreational staff; there will be 10 weeks of Summer Camp at Big Rock Park, which will include field trips, swim days and a variety of activities, the Teen Center is currently closed for Spring Break and is being cleaned; partnerships with SD Nights and

local Santee Library also continue. Recruiting for Junior Leader program during summer day camps is open for registration. Senior Group attended the San Diego Central Library; on April 16 bus trip to Getty Museum and May 10 is Spring Luncheon. Parks and fields have been very busy. Big Rock Pickleball will host fundraising Tournaments on April 15, May 20 and May 21. Spring youth sports are ongoing, as well as private events. Big Rock park off-leash dog park signs have been ordered and in production. Discussion was held.
