- 5. STAFF REPORT/PARK DEVELOPMENT Director Nick Chavez shared that Shadow Hill Park, Town Center Community Park and Big Rock Park may receive water bottle filling stations from a Cal Recycle grant. Staff is working on an RFP Request for Proposal to fix damaged lodge pole fencing at Walker Preserve Trail. The damaged slide at Town Center Community Park East has been replaced. Staff is working on adding additional tree maintenance to the West Coast Arborist contract. Discussion was held.

Recreation Manager, Anne Morrison shared that a new Recreation Coordinator will be starting on January 19, 2023. The Winter Recreation Guide is out and registration is open. Teen Center has re-opened today. Senior Group held their annual holiday luncheon on December 16. Santee TV video shown.
