- 4. SAN DIEGO RIVER PARK FOUNDATION Presenter: Sarah Hutmacher, Chief Operating Officer Sarah educated the committee about the valuable efforts of this 501:3C non-profit organization. The SDRP conducts regular river clean ups along the entire San Diego River. SDRP provides Education Programs, Community Clean-Ups, Data Collection and Surveys and Water Quality Monitoring. In FY 2022, SDRP picked up 21 tons of trash with 227 volunteers and 676 hours of service out of the river. Discussion was held.

5. STAFF REPORT/PARK DEVELOPMENT UPDATE/INFORMATION -

Director of Community Services, Nicolas Chavez presented a presentation of the remodeled kiosks in several parks. Nick announced a Community Clean Up on September 16 from 8am-12pm at City Hall. Nick advised that the synthetic fields at Town Center Community park need to be renovated and staff is working on submitting applications for grants. He stated that the City of Santee is looking into an Age-Friendly Plan. Nick explained that the Reserve Policy is being reviewed and will be researched and presented at a further date.

Recreation Services Manager, Anne Morrison presented a video on the Summer Concert recap. Special Events Supervisor, Becky Lowndes updated the committee on Brews and Bites ticket sales, vendor updates and volunteer requests. Discussion was held. Becky also added that there will be a Movie in the Park on September 30, Spooky Snapshots on October 31, Blood Drive on October 30, and Santee Holiday Lighting on November 17 as well as a new Selfies with Santa on November 18.

Anne Morrison continued with updates on summer camp and the Fall Recreation brochure is available, Teen Center, Senior programming – mobilehome park outreach, parks/fields and pickleball banner program. Anne added that staff is working with the Santee Community Foundation to reactivate the committee with a tentative meeting in November. Discussion was held.

Sam Rensberry thanked the San Diego River Park foundation for all of their hard work. Tony Hurst recently retired and will be very missed. 400 sandbags were handed out for the recent tropical storm. Discussion was held.

Dan shared that he was recently interviewed by 10News, as they are spotlighting the City of Santee. Dan added that the Kiwanis Club will have a Miracle Mile event on October 28. Key Club is making art out of quarters. Proceeds go to Rady's Children hospital.

Ryan McCarthy inquired if the SPARC account is building interest on the balance. Discussion was held. Ryan inquired about the landscaping area at the corner of Mast Blvd and West Hills Parkway. Discussion was held.
