# Mandatory Training Week June 17-21, 2024 (Mandatory training week required for all Jr Leaders)

This week prepares Jr Camp Leaders for their roles with Summer Day Camp program. Participants must successfully complete the mandatory training week in order to be eligible to participate in the remaining day camp weeks. Returning Jr Leaders will help mentor the incoming Jr Leaders. Registration for weeks 2-9 is open immediately with registration into the Mandatory Training Week. Space is limited to 15 Jr Leaders and registration is on a first come first service basis. Participants who register for weeks 2-9 but do not successfully complete the training week will be credited or transferred to X-Factor Camp (price increase and age restrictions apply).

Training week includes learning how to interact and supervise children, CPR and First Aid certification, team building, job application and resume writing tips, a guest speaker, interview tips and tricks, activity planning and more! Completion of the program includes a letter of recommendation and documentation of community service hours.
