

## **Pool Demolition & Backfill Requirements**

- 1. A demolition permit is required to demolish or bury a swimming pool in the City of Santee. The County Assessor will be provided with the record of removal.
- 2. In order to obtain a demolition permit please provide a site plan of subject property with a completed permit application. The site plan should clearly indicate dimensions of all existing structures, property lines, and location of pool.
- 3. Upon receiving the building permit several inspections will be required prior to final inspection.
- 4. Prior to backfilling the City Building Inspector will verify that there are 1' diameter holes per 10'x10' surface area in the base of the pool. Place a minimum of five holes in the deep end of the pool. The sides of pool must be dropped down 2'.
- 5. Backfilling can begin once the Building Inspector has verified the placement of the holes in the base of the pool. Backfill materials shall consist of a mixture of 75% clean soil and 25% six-inch maximum rock. As an alternative, the compaction report will not be required if the pool is backfilled with pea gravel (1/4" or 3/8") or sand, however, the top 24 inches shall be backfilled with soil to allow for planting of vegetation.
- 6. A compaction report will be required if the placement of a structure on the backfilled area is proposed.
